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## 2016 EBERLE VINEYARD SELECTION CABERNET SAUVIGNON

*Eberle Winery, Paso Robles*

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*“It seems like I am forever seeking Cabernet Sauvignons that smell like the grape and deliver some of the structure I believe is necessary for it to work with food. Many high-falutin’ areas in the wine world do not do that anymore, preferring later picking, weight, concentration, intensity, and a move away from varietal characteristics. It seems to be what sells. Gary Eberle founded his property in Paso Robles decades ago because it provided the proper soils and climates to make Cabernet with personality, and his most recent wine delivers just what he has always delivered. The aromas of cherry and dried herbs (sage, bay leaf) and a depth of CS varietal-ness you rarely find in Cabernet. Winemaker Chris Eberle (no relation to Gary!) did a superb job with this widely available wine.”*
