### 2023 EBERLE CÔTES-DU-RÔBLES RHÔNE-STYLE RED BLEND

This is one of the most classic Paso Robles bottlings, and this vintage's fresh profile really pairs well with the region's warmer days. The blend of 58% Grenache, 34% Mourvèdre and 8% Syrah starts with aromas of smashed raspberry, hibiscus and fennel pollen on the zesty nose. The palate is juicy and bright, offering quaffable red fruit and light spice flavors.

### 2023 EBERLE SYRAH

From the second-oldest Syrah vineyard in the U.S., which Gary Eberle planted in 1973, this Côte-Rôtie-inspired red speaks of black pepper and bloody beef broth as brilliant red and blue fruit bursts in the mouth.

### 2023 ESTATE CABERNET SAUVIGNON

Spending 22 months in barrel, it's Eberle Winery's longest-matured wine, with aromas of smashed berries and mocha. Zippy white pepper, cassis, and black-cherry liqueur reveal its dynamic and full-bodied soul. Ideal acidity adds a freshness that startles, and tannins are supple, even-toned, and balanced.

### 2024 CÔTES-DU-RÔBLES ROSÉ

This is a bold style of rosé, and always one of the crowd-pleasers for Paso wine lovers on a warm summer day. Aromas of cherry, bubblegum and orange sorbet lead from the nose into a palate where strawberry soda pop flavors are cut by a firm tension.

This classic Paso Cab still shines, offering fresh aromas of blackberry, loam, graphite, purple flower and woodspice on the nose. The palate snaps with fresh lilac flavors, staying high-toned and floral into the finish.

There's a vibrant freshness to this bottling of Zin from three vineyards, offering black cherry, French toast spice and graphite aromas on the nose. The palate is tense and peppery, with dense cherry flavors balanced by a snappy acidity.

### 2023 EBERLE ESTATE VIOGNIER

This is the sixth vintage of this estate bottling. It's a floral beauty, with no trace of high alcohol. Stone fruit and honeysuckle shine, offering an unctuousness and a weight of vanilla confection. It finishes with the airy nature and flavor of lemon cake. This wine was awarded Best White from this year's Central Coast Wine Competition.

### 2023 EBERLE ESTATE CHARDONNAY

Regional pioneer Gary Eberle has long believed Chardonnay can work in the Paso warmth, and this bottling provides solid evidence. Aromas of lime and pear are familiar and lively. The palate of citrus-spiked peach and coconut is both rich and energetic, with ample texture as well.
