#### **CABERNET SAUVIGNON**

Gary Eberle's Clone 6 is the foundation for this flowery, concentrated, 22-month French oak-aged estate red. Lilacs and lavender surround dark plum on the nose. The flavors are concentrated, as blackberry engages with a string of earthy, savory notes. Black olive, coffee with slathered slate in dark chocolate are remarkable on the palate. Floral notes continue to deliver a rush of flavor on the finish. Wow.

This is a classic.

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#### 2021 CÔTES-DU-RÔBLES BLANC

This blend of 65% Roussanne, 20% Grenache Blanc and 15% Viognier is always a bold and ripe Rhône showcase. Aromas of candied peach, cantaloupe, honeydew and plumeria lead from the nose into a palate dripping with peach cobbler and more tropical flower flavors, staying clean and fresh into the finish.MATT KETTMANN

#### 2021 EBERLE ZINFANDEL

From this storied producer comes a newer, fresh style of Zinfandel, sources from three vineyards. Aromas of blackberry jam, wet stone and cracked pepper make for a complex nose. The palate is tense in structure, with creamy flavors of boysenberry and more peppery spice.
