Delicate and chalky on the nose, this blend of Grenache Blanc, Roussanne and Viognier offers pear, honeysuckle and nectarine aromas. There is solid zip on the palate, where cantaloupe, lemon skin and dried apple flavors are touched with exotic saffron spice.

Lively and zesty, yet well-structured, offering blueberry, savory herb and smoked pepper flavors that take on elegance toward refined tannins. Drink now through 2025.

#### EBERLE 2017 SYRAH, PASO ROBLES

SA nose of dark chocolate, coffee and wet earth, this wine is exceptional in texture and flavor. Black tea tannins, walnut and blackberry lean in to a line of minerality. Black pepper strikes a chord on the finish.

#### 2018 EBERLE ESTATE CHARDONNAY

Bright and leesy, this has a pleasant briskness to what ought to be a warm-climate wine, simple and salty, with a lively green-apple texture that's framed by a dusty, windswept phenolic grip.
